COVID safety measures (1 of 2)



2G+1 required

- Everyone attending will be required to present proof of vaccination against or of recovery from COVID-19, along with their ID².
- Additionally, we will require an official negative test from every participant for each day they participate in the event. This applies to all participants, even if you have already received a booster vaccination.
- Unfortunately, anyone who cannot provide this proof cannot enter the event.



Definition of 2G+ status

- You are considered "fully vaccinated" if:
 - You have had at least 2COVID vaccinations, at least 14 days ago, or
 - You are recovered and then had at least one COVID vaccination, at least 14 days ago, or
 - You have had one COVID vaccination and were recently recovered
- You are considered "recovered" if you can show proof of a positive PCR test dated 28 to 90 days ago.



Testing

- If you can provide a negative, official, same-day COVID antigen test at your arrival, you may enter directly after providing proof of your vaccination/recovery status³.
- If you cannot provide a negative, official, same-day COVID antigen test, you can take a test at either event location (UdL or Radialsystem) prior to entry.
- In case of a positive test result, we ask you to report back to our test center immediately while wearing a mask.



Masking

- Everyone is required to wear a mask when entering the event locations until 2G+ status is proven.
- If you take a test directly at the event location, you may enter the event directly after, but are still required to wear a mask for until you have received a negative test result by e-mail (15-20 min).
- Wearing a mask will also be required when in the auditorium area, unless the person is onstage or posing a question to the moderator

How to present your vaccination status:

- 1. As part of the registration process, we ask all guests to present, accompanied by their ID, their current vaccination or recovery status.
- 2. At the registration counter we will be using the App CovPass Check (by Robert Koch Institut) to verify your COVID certificate
- 3. Therefore you need to present the **individual QR code** you have received along with your digital COVID certificate. You can present this QR code either **digitally or printed**.
- 4. The CovPass Check App is able to verify the valid "EU Digital COVID Certificate¹" or from those countries who have joined the "EU Digital COVID Certificate" System. Please find a list of those non-EU countries here.
- 5. Please make sure to have a valid certificate available. The validity of your certificate is either marked on the printed certificate you've received after your vaccination or, depending on the app you are currently using, marked in your app.
- 6. Please download the CovPass App or Corona-Warn App beforehand and check the status of your certificate(s), to ensure you don't have any problems accessing your valid documentation.
- 7. In case of problems please prepare to bring all available official documents to verify your vaccination or recovery status in any other way. It is important that these contain the necessary data (identification of the person, type of vaccine and date of vaccination) and take into account the ability to verify the authenticity, validity and integrity of the certificate.
- 8. For those of you coming from the US: please bring all available official documents from the US to verify your vaccination or recovery status. Reach out to us (talentmeetsbertelsmann@bertelsmann.de) if you require additional guidance on which documents.

Please note: Those who cannot show valid proof of vaccination and/or recovery will not be allowed into the event.
